What to Expect After Discharge From Hospital

• You may feel burning when you urinate for the next one to two week. Taking ural will help with this discomfort.

- It is normal to see a small amount of blood in your urine (usually intermittently) for the next 4 weeks. This will make your urine look pink.
- Most patients will feel back to normal after one week
- Avoid sexual activity until advised by your doctor, usually 4 weeks after surgery
- It is common for urinary frequency and urgency to persistent for 3-4 weeks after surgery

Call Your Doctor or Nurse if You Have:

- Blood clots in your urine
- A temperature of 38.0° C or higher
- An inability to urinate
- Any other problems or concerns
